


Chapter 1 User Interface




#	Toolbar	Functions
0	Basic Operation	Functions such as capture images, freeze images, live images and etc.
2	Annotation Tools	Provide annotation tools to mark or annotate the displayed image.
3	Camera Settings	Provide operation functions which are the same with keys on the remote control / machine's control panel.
4	Options	Provide video and audio setting.
5	Video Tools	Provide video functions: Start and stop recording.

Control the live image via the *Camera Settings* interface. The operating procedure is the same as the **remote control** and **control panel** of the **Visual Presenter**. Refer to the user manual for more information.

<Note> The display of the button may vary depending on product functions. An inactive button will grey out.



2.4 Options



- 1. Video compress type: Set the video format.
- 2. **Enable Audio Recorder**: Enable the audio recorder.
- 3. Audio source: Set the audio source.
- 4. Audio compression type: Set the audio compression type.

<Note>You need to enable the [Enable Audio Recorder] before setting the [Audio compression type].

to freeze the live image of queue.


3.3 I would like to capture images

3.4.2 Key in the file name then press [Save].




3.4 I would like to annotate the displayed image

3.5.1 Press



to open the annotation tools.

3.5.2 The default mode is [Pointer Tool]. You can select another annotation tool.




3.5.3 Select a color for drawing.



3.5.4 Set the value of Line width (If the value is higher, the line is thicker).



3.5.5 Mark or annotate the displayed image.



<Remark>You can press



to capture images that you draw.


3.5 I would like to add textual annotation to images.

3.6.1 Press




to open the annotation tools.

3.6.2 Select [Text Tool]



- 3.6.3 The [Text Tool] window will pop up when you click the screen for the text to be added in.
- 3.6.4 Enter the text in blank fields and click [OK].



3.6.5 Click [T] to change fonts settings (size/color/effect).

<Remark> You can press



to capture images that you draw.

3.6 I would like to record video

<Note> Please make sure the mode is live image.

<Remark> If you want to record audio at the same time, please refer to <u>2.4 Options, Enable Audio</u>

<u>Recorder</u>

3.6.1 Press




to open the video tool

3.6.2 Press [Record]



then a Save As window will be displayed.



- 3.6.3 Key in the file name then press [Save] to start recording.
- 3.6.4 Press [Stop] to stop recording.
- 3.6.5 Press



to close the record tool.

3.7 I would like to display full screen



to switch to full screen mode.


3.7.2 Press [ESC] key to return the normal mode

<Remark> While in the full screen display mode, right-clicking can activate Annotation Tools.

4.1 Uninstall queue

4.1.1 Select queue Uninstall.

- 4.1.3 The system will start running uninstall applications and removing related components.
